 Recognizing and understanding more than one meaning for a word demonstrates the depth of a student's vocabulary, while knowing when and how to use multiple

Easily Confused Words: Mnemonic Homonyms

Easily Confused Words: Mnemonic Homonyms
 A mnemonic is a memorization tool such as a short phrase or image
 For instance, when music students memorize the phrase "Every Good Boy Does Fine," the phrase helps them remember the order of letters E G B D F on the musical scale
 Another phrase, "Oh Be a Fine Girl/Guy, Kiss Me Right Now" helps

Tricks to Remember Homonym Spellings

Tricks to Remember Homonym Spellings
 Here are some mnemonic (that is, memory) tricks to help you remember the correct spellings of homonyms (words that sound alike but have different meanings and spellings) and words that are almost homonyms
 The trick, in most cases, is to think about the spelling of only part of the word and what that means
